

My Camp Contract



Welcome to 2019 Summer Playground! Please read carefully our Summer Playground policies. This contract must be signed and turned in at the playground site on the first day that the child attends camp. Please call our office with any questions at: (586) 446-2700.

Come and Go as You Want Policy

Please note that although the staff will exercise their best judgment, the playground staff cannot require that your child(ren) stay at the site, and therefore cannot force him or her to stay if the child(ren) are attempting to leave the site. A child's attendance on the playground will be left up to the instructions of the parents or guardian. Children are not obligated to attend every day or even all day. Staff will be on site if children wish to stay during the lunch break.

Discipline Policy

Each playground will have posted rules and disciplinary procedures. Children are expected to follow these rules. If the rules are not followed, possible suspension and even removal from the program may take place. Any child that brings fireworks (lit or not lit) to the playground program will be automatically suspended and possibly expelled from the playground program. This includes poppers and sparklers. Each site is also operated as a bully free zone, with immediate consequences for anybody found bullying another participant. Parents will be notified if a child is misbehaving. Fighting is an automatic 3-day suspension with no exceptions. If a child is consistently disruptive and not following rules, a behavior plan will be arranged in a parent meeting.

Pick-Up Policy

Please remember that the playgrounds close and the staff leaves at 3 p.m. each day. If at 3 p.m. a child has not been picked up, every effort will be made to contact a parent or guardian. At 3:15 p.m., the child or children will be taken to the Parks and Recreation office by a Parks and Recreation Supervisor. At 5 p.m., they will be taken to the Sterling Heights Police Department. Each time the staff must wait after 3 p.m., a \$25 (\$40 for multiple children) late fee will be charged to the parent. The late fee must be paid at the Recreation office inside Fillmore Elementary School (8655 Irving Road) before the child may attend the program again. Payment may be made by cash, check or charge (MasterCard, Visa or Discover only). Checks should be made payable to: Treasurer, City of Sterling Heights.
